Let's check the answers and see how you got on!

Question 1: Who can put photos and videos on to the internet?

The correct answer is

A) Anyone

Anyone can upload photos and videos on to the internet, so you need to be very careful when going online. Always ask an adult you trust for help if anything makes you feel worried or upset.

Question 2: When a photo or video is uploaded (put) on to the internet, how long does it stay there?

The correct answer is

A) Forever

Once you put something online, it can stay there forever. Even if you choose to delete something that you have put online, anyone who has seen it could make a copy, save it or share it again. The internet never forgets!

Question 3: Which of the following things are your personal information?

The correct answer is

A) All of these things

Your personal information consists of many different things, such as your full name, date of birth, home and school address, phone numbers, email address, passwords, and your friends' names and addresses too. Keep these safe by not putting them on the internet and not sharing them with anyone.

Question 4: You want to put a favourite photo on to the internet. Who must you ask before you do it?

The correct answer is

A) Your parents

It is your parents or carers that need to know if you want to put something on the internet. They will be able to help you do it properly, make sure that you know who will be able to see it, and check that what you have chosen is suitable for others to see.

Question 5: Who can you ask for help if you're worried about something you've seen on the internet?

The correct answer is

A) Any adult that you trust

A trusted adult could be a parent, carer, grandparent, aunt or uncle, teacher or sports team leader etc. Telling a friend or older sibling can help you to feel better about something, but a trusted adult can give you the best advice.

Question 6: Your friend has been upset by another player in an online game. How can you be a good friend and help them?

The correct answer is

A) All of these things!

It is always important to be kind online, even if someone is trying to be unkind. A trusted adult will be able to help you to decide what to do next, like blocking that person and reporting them, and your friend will feel much better knowing that an adult is there to help them.
